Classes

Classes will probably run in this order, but we may need to change the order based on the numbers of entries. All classes are run in accordance with British Eventing rules. Riders cannot compete more than 4 horses and a horse may only compete in one class. A 4YO horses may enter any class.

1. 1ft6 - 2ft One Day Event

For combinations who have not won more than 3 one day event or hunter trials. Horses with no BE points.

1a. Lead rein / assisted section

1b. Open

Dressage test: Unaffiliated - Introductory - B(2009). SJ & Cross-country fences max 2ft.

Cross-Country will not be timed. Entry fee £30.00

2. 2ft3 One Day Event

For combinations who have not won more than 3 one day event or hunter trials. Horses with no BE points.

Dressage test: BE 96 (2016). SJ & Cross-country fences max 2ft3. Cross-Country optimum time based on a speed of 400m/min. Entry fee £50.00
