Online entries open for BRC teams and individuals on Monday 23rd 2016 and for Open section ODE entries on Monday 6th June 2016 at equoevents.com with a non-refundable £1.92 booking fee. Entries will close when full or on Tuesday 14th June at 12.00, whichever comes first. Entries are on a first come first served basis.

We are ONLY accepting online entries - sorry, but no phone or postal entries.

All entrants in the Team and Individual Qualifier classes must be members of affiliated Riding Clubs and must be eligible for that class in accordance with BRC rules. Entrants in Open classes must have reached their 12th birthday by the date of the event and horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old.

The course will be open for walking between 2-6pm on Sat 18th June 2016 or on the day.

British Riding Club Classes Rules:

- All BRC competitors must have an up-to-date Equine Influenza Certificate which must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to a qualifying competition. The competitor is responsible for producing the Certificate when collecting their paper number.
- Hats and body protectors will also be checked
- All hats must be tagged before competitors may ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition in the Secretary's. See BRC Rules Appendix 4. For 2016, hats must be tagged with orange tags.
- All Riding Clubs are responsible for making their Preliminary Entry to the BRC Office by
 Friday 27th May, using the form available on the BRC Downloads page or paying online at
 www.britishhorse.com selecting Riding Club Entries. The preliminary entry fee of £13 per
 individual or £51 per team must accompany the Preliminary Entry to BRC and is in addition
 to the entry fee payable to Moreton-Russell Ltd when making your online entry. Preliminary
 Entry Fees do not apply to Open classes.
